## Downtown Parking System

Getting downtown is easy and parking is even easier.

### **P** First Hour Free

There are 2,034 parking spaces in five well-lit and covered off-street garages owned by Capital City Development Corporation and operated by Republic Parking Northwest. Short-term (hourly) and monthly rates are available. Visitors receive the first hour free in the Downtown Core district and each additional hour is \$2.50.

### **20** City On-Street: First 20 Minutes Free

Push the blue button on any downtown meter from 8am to 6pm Monday through Friday and the first 20 minutes are free. Buy some time with the Boise City Parking Card, which is pre-paid and rechargeable, available at City Hall.
